BECOMES FIRST NON-GANDHI CONGRESS PRESIDENT IN 24 YEARS

The Congress got its first non-Gandhi president in 24 years after more than 9,500 votes cast to choose between senior leaders Mallikarjun Kharge and Shashi Tharoor as counted

The Congress has got its first non-Canchi president in 24 years on 19th Oddoer after more than 9,500 votes casted to choose between serior leaders Mallikarjun Kharqe and Snashi Tharoar ware counted to cap the election contest, the sixthinits137-year-ddhistary.

The counting of the votes casted on Manday began at 10 am on Wednesday at the AICCheadquartershere

While Kharge is considered the firm favourite with his perceived proximity to the Gandrisand a large number of serior leaders backing him, Tharoor has pitched himself as the candidate of change

The process of bringing all the ballot boxes from the 68 polling booths set up across the country by the party which completed by Tuesday. The sealed boxes were kept in a "strongroom" at the party headquarter.

The sealed ball of boxes were opened before the candidates' agents and the votes were mixed repeatedly as they were addedfromvariousboxes

Congress central election authority chairman Machusudan Mistry has expressed satisfaction with the party's presidential polls process, saying it was "free, fair and

It was way back in 1939, when an electoral contest decided who would be the Congress president and in fact, Mahatma

Then in 1950 came the Congress' first post-Independence election for the post of party president when Purshottam Das Tandon and Adharya Kripalani faced off. Surprisingly, Tandon seenasa Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Iovalist, won the contest, trumping the then Prime Minister Javaharlal Nebrulschrice.

In 1977, following the resignation of Dev Kant Barocahas party president in the wake of the defeat in the Lok Sabha polls, K. Brahmananda Reobly defeated Sobhartha Shankar RayandKaranSnghinthepartyspdlsforACCtrief.

The next election that needed a contest came 20 years later in 1997 when Staram Kesi squared off in a trianquar contestwith Sharad Pavar and Rajesh Pllot.


HISTORY OF INDIAN NATIONAL CONGRESS PARTY



HIMACHAL PRADESH ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS: FIRST LIST OF BJP AND CONGRESS CANDIDATES RELEASED

The Bharatiya Janata Party has released a list of 62 candidates for the Himadhal Pradesh Assembly elections This comes a day after Congress released its firstlist of 46 candidates Chief Minister Jairam Thakur, serior leader Aril Sharma and Satpal Singh Satti are themostprominent names featured on the list.

While Thakur will contest from Seraj, Sharma and Satti vill contest from Mand and Una. The new worstituted Central Bedion Committee of the BJP met for the first time to finalise its list of candidates. KARNATAKA HIJAB BAN CASE: SUPREME COURT DELIVERS SPLIT VERDICT

The Supreme Court delivered a solit vend of on the ban of wearing of hijabin educational institutions in Karnatakawith one judge affirming that the state government is authorised to enforce uniform in schools and the other calling hijaba matter of choice that cannot be stifled by the state Justice Herrant Gupta, in his judgment, dismissed all the appeals filed against the Karnataka high court judgment, which held in March that wearing of hijab by Muslim women is not mandatory in Islam and that the Karnataka government was empowered to enforce the uniformmendate.

Hovever, Justice Suchanshu Dhulia differed from the serior judge on the bench and allowed all the appeals Reading out the operative part of his judgment, Justice Dhulia said that wearing of hijabisa matter of droice for a Muslimgirl and there cannot be any restriction against it

Questing the state government's prohibitory notification, Justice Dhulia added that concerns regarding the education of a girl drild weighed the most on his mind and the ban on hijab would certainly come in the way of making her life hetter

In view of the dissenting views, the matter has been referred to the Crief Justice of India for constituting an appropriatebench

The extensive hearing in the case last month witnessed almost two dozen lawyers arguing over a spectrum of issues on behalf of girl students. Islamic bodies rights groups lavyersandadivists

While the petitioners drallenging the high court order covered in their arguments the right to practice religion freedom to dress as a matter of expression and identity, right to accessed uration and alleged urreasonableness of the state's mandate, the Karnataka government maintained throughout the proceedings that their diroular toenforceuriformvæsreligion-neutral andaimedonly at promotinguriformityanddsipline

The source of power to enforce a dress code was also questioned by the petitioners, arguing the state had no legit authority to mandate uniform, adding the February draular dd notdarify whether the restriction acquinst hijab was in the interest of decency, health or public order. Several lawyers also demanded the case be referred to a rine judge bench where issues relating to the scope of judidal reviewin matters of faith are currently pending

The state government was led by solicitor general (SG) Tushar Mehta. Additional solicitor general KIVINataraj and Kamataka's advocate general Prabhuling K Navadoj also arguedinsupport of the high court judgment

The SG began by daining that the controversy over hijab wasmanufactured by Popular Front of India (PFI) to trigger a social urrest, and added that enforcement of uriform carnotvidatealegal right, much lessa fundamental right. According to Mehta, the state government did not touch any religious aspect but made uniform mandatory through a February circular in the interest of unity, equality and distipline. He added that for a practice to be proved as an essential religious practice, a party must establish it is so fundamental and compelling that following a religion is not possible vithout it

ASG Nataraj, on his part, underlined that discipline in sthod is the only issue involved and a discussion on any other aspect is an unnecessary diversion. He contended that enforcement of a dress code is imperative for promoting unity in educational institutions and that the statesækstorestrictall symbolsof religious observances in

Arguing on the dominant effect of the February circular, state's advocate general Navadoj arqued that the foundation of the opvernment order was to mandate uniform, which was completely permissible under the statutory authority, and therefore, any daimof incidental vidation of a right must be established fully. He also said that everything mentioned in the Quran cannot become an essential facetof religion

Reading on the split verdict, BC Nagesh, Karnataka educationministerval comed the judgement

"As a democratic opverment, we welcome whatever judgment we have received from the Supreme Court. But we expected a better judgment, as you know the world over vørnen are demanding not to væar hijab or burka. There is a solit judgment, so the verdict given by the Kamataka high court is valid. In that context, we will continue to followwhat is currently existing rules (for educational institutions in the state)," said Nagesh

For the first time, IVF dinics in Australia and New Zealand have reported data about the scale and range of male fertility problems in couples who have IVF. Nevodata released by the Australia and New Zealand Assisted Reproduction Database (ANZARD) today reveal about one-third of all IVF cydesperformed in 2020 induded a dagnosis of maleinfertility

Although most male fertility problems can't be prevented, there are things men can do to improve spermouality and the drance of natural conception

Most male infertility is due to the testes failing to make any or enough normal sperm to allow conception Alovspermount, spermnot moving normally, or a high proportion of abnormally shaped sperm reduce capacity to fertilise eggs

In most cases, the cause of male infertility is unexplained A specific cause can only be pinpointed in about 40 per cent of infertile men They include genetic abnormalities, past infection, trauma to the testides and damage to soem production - for example from cancer treatment. Some men have no soem in their ejaculate (a condition called azcospermia). This can be due to blocked sperm tubes, which may be a birth defect, or follow/vasedomy or other damage

Inaminority of cases, infrequent or poorly timed intercourse, or sexual problems such as credile dysfunction or ejaculation failure cause the infertility

The least common problem is deficiency of hormonal signals from the pituitary gland (a gland on the brain which makes, stores and releasesharmones). This can be openetical follow issues such as a pituitary tumour. Treatment with harmone injections aims to restore natural fertility.

Orroric diseases such as obesity or diabetes environmental exposures (such as chemicals in the workplace) and lifestyle factors (such as smoking and recreational drug use) can contribute to a rexact bate poor spermouality.



For couples with male factor infertility, intracytoplasmicsperminjection (ICS) is needed to fertilise the exps and give them a chance of havingababy.

ICS follows the same process as IVF, except ICS involvesthedrectinjedianofasinglesperminto each expusing technically advanced equipment, as apposed to IVF, where thousands of scermare added to each eggin the hope one will fertilise it

The just released ANZARD report shows the drance of a baby for men with male infertility is comparable with other infertility diagnoses Hovever, studies show that for courdes who don't have male factor infertility, ICS offers no advantage over IVF in terms of the drance of havingababy.

Although most male infertility is not preventable, there are some things men can do to keep their sperm healthy. It takes about three months for sperm to mature, so making healthy changes at least three months before trying for a baby gives the best chance of conception and having a healthy baby. Here are five things you can do to lockaftervourscerm


